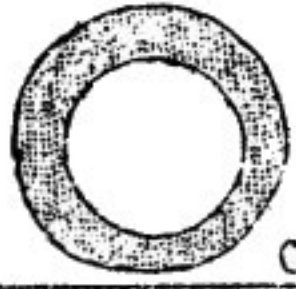

## CITY TAPPING TO BE HELD AT N.Y.U.

An Ordeal Honor Tapping Ceremony will be held on the campus of New York University, at Burnside and University Aves., for the induction of new brothers into the Ranachqua Lodge, N.Y.U. It will take place Saturday evening, June 14, at 8:30 P.M.

Notices were sent out by the City Elections Committee, and about forty scoutmasters have replied to the affirmative. Elections are being taken, and it is estimated that approximately seventy to eighty scouts who have shown themselves to be outstanding in qualities of cheerfulness and service will be tapped.

All scouts who have been nominated will be seated in the Tapper's Circle. Last year, at the Tapping at Alpine, only the scouts who were elected to the Order of the Arrow were present at the Tapping, as it was not feasible to bring all scouts who were nominated to New Jersey.

The actual arrangements for the Tapping have been made by the Ritual and Regalia Committee, under the direction of Ronald Clifford. Stan Leber, Dave Silberstein, and Norman Decker will narrate during the ceremony.

All Bronx Scout Troops, and Explorer Posts will be notified, and are invited. The ceremony will be open to the public.

The ordeal and induction ceremony will take place, Saturday, June 21, at Alpine Scout Camp, for those scouts who are tapped, and who will not attend Camp Ranachqua this summer. Special arrangements will be made for those scouts who will be unable to take the Ordeal and ritual on the Sabbath.

ON ARROW SASHES--

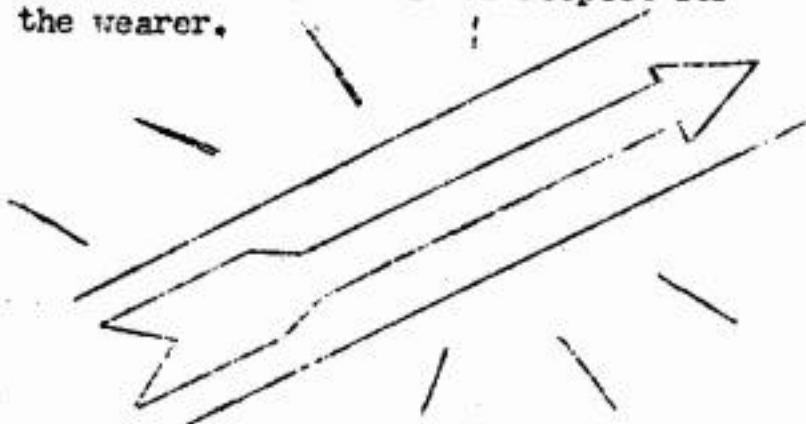
Have you ever attended a Boy Scout function where there were Order of the Arrow members present in uniform?

Perhaps they were serving as ushers, or performing some other such service.

What did you first notice about them? Well, they seemed to be a group of clean-cut, well groomed fellows, wearing clean uniforms. Did you notice, however that some of these fellows were wearing Order of the Arrow Sashes that were turning just a wee bit grey in color.

A situation such as this can be easily remedied. The sashes can either be washed or dry-cleaned. But as washing may prove to be risky, as colors may run, dry-cleaning is recommended. You can bring the sash into a neighborhood Tailor Shop, and have it dry-cleaned for a nominal sum. This is the ideal solution, as it saves you (or your mother) the fuss, bother and risk of washing.

A clean Order of the Arrow Sash, when worn properly, enhances the appearance of the uniform, and gains respect for the wearer.
